### Brief Description of Undergraduate Courses Taught: (Course Title – Code: Description)

1	<b>Introduction to infectious diseases/</b> Damascus University/ faculty of medicine/5 <sup>th</sup> -year (1998-2006): A 6 credit-hour course that extends over one semester and is offered to 5 <sup>th</sup> -year medical students. The course objectives are to teach basic skills and the main subjects in Infectious diseases.
2	<b>Bedside teaching/</b> Damascus University/ faculty of medicine/4 <sup>th</sup> , 5 <sup>th</sup> and 6 <sup>th</sup> -year (1998-2006): A 10-credit-hour course in Medicine that one academic year and is offered to 4 <sup>th</sup> , 5 <sup>th</sup> and 6 <sup>th</sup> year medical students. The course concentrates on history-taking, physical examination, patients' management, follow-up and principles of therapeutics.
3	<b>Introduction to Medicine Course (MDMD 451):</b> A 6 credit-hour course that extends over a 6-week period and is offered to the 4th-year medical students for 4 rotations per year. The course emphasizes history-taking and physical examination.
4	<b>5th-year Clerkship Course in Medicine (MDMD 501):</b> A 6-credit-hour course that is taught over a 6-week period and given to the 5th-year medical students for 6 rotations per year. The course objectives are to teach basic skills and the main subjects in Internal Medicine.
5	<b>6th Year Clerkship Course in Medicine (MDMD 551):</b> A 10-credit-hour course in Medicine that lasts over 9 weeks and is offered to 6th year medical students for 4 rotations per year. The course concentrates on patients' management, follow-up and principles of therapeutics.
