

CT Scan



What is CT scan?

A computerized tomography scan (CT or CAT scan) uses computers and rotating X-ray machines to create crosssectional images of the body.



What are the precautionary measures before performing this procedure?

 Conducting a blood test and evaluating kidney function if the test is using contrast material.



- If you suffer from asthma, chest allergy, or sensitivity to iodine. You will be prescribed medication to reduce any complications may result from using contrast material.
- Make sure there is no pregnancy before the date of the procedure.



Why Is a CT scan Performed?

A CT scan has many uses, but it's particularly well-suited for diagnosing diseases and evaluating injuries. The imaging technique can help your doctor:

 Diagnose infections, muscle disorders, and bone fractures.



- pinpoint the location of masses and tumors (including cancer)
- Study the blood vessels and other internal structures.



Assess the extent of internal injuries and internal bleeding.

Why Is a CT scan Performed?

- Guide procedures, such as surgeries and biopsies.
- Monitor the effectiveness of treatments for certain medical conditions, including cancer and heart disease.



What are the preparations required for such procedure?

Not to eat and drink for 4 hours before the examination.



 Wearing comfortable, spacious clothes free of metal parts and leaving all your valuables at home.



 Arrive 30 minutes before the appointment to prepare and fill out the approval form for the CT scan with the dye, if the examination requires this.



What are the preparations required for such procedure?

• If you feel itching or a rash after the dye, you must go to the emergency department directly.

 It is advised to drink extra fluids during the rest of the day to help the body expel the dye.

 If you are diabetic and are taking Glucophage medicine, you should stop taking the medicine for two days
